

INFORMATION ABOUT THE PELAGIC SAFARI: MAGBAY

We recommend not buying your airfare until the safari is confirmed. However, we highly recommend making airfare reservations with anticipation.

MAXIMUM CAPACITY: 12 GUESTS

FEE PER PERSON: \$13,000 MXN

WHAT DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE?

- 3 open ocean outings (Approximately 7 hours per safari)
- Room accommodation for 4 days (T,F,S,S), Three nights (T,F,S) in Puerto San Carlos (PSC) at Hotel Brennan
 - Private Bathroom
 - Air conditioning
 - Double Room (in case you are traveling alone or you have an odd number of people traveling in your group, the hotel room will be shared with another member in the expedition)
 - For a private room you would need to pay an additional \$2,000 mxn
 - Land transportation (La Paz Airport- PSC- La Paz)

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE TOUR?

- Room accommodations in La Paz and/or Los Cabos. Because of the expedition's agenda we recommend to make plans to arrive on Wednesday or Thursday before 1PM and depart on Monday any time.
- Hotel 7 Crown Centro, La Paz. (Recommended accommodation, we can make the reservation for you if necessary)
- Alcoholic Beverages (Prohibited at Pelagic Safari Outings), permitted and for sale at PSC.
- Snorkeling gear (full wetsuit, diving mask, snorkel and fins) in case you don't own one, you can borrow the gear by making a deposit of \$1,000 mxn that will be reimbursed once the gear is returned in the best conditions. It is also possible to individually rent your gear at La Paz. Pelagic Safaris: Magbay is a snorkeling activity, therefore it is not necessary to rent certified diving equipment.

WHAT TO PACK

- Wetsuit de 3-5 mm (depending on the season)
- Fins
- Diving Mask and snorkel
- Dry Bag (to keep your belongings dry)
- Long Sleeve T-Shirt (to protect you from the sun and from chilly afternoons)
- Raincoat
- Jacket or Sweatshirt
- Cap or hat
- Sunblock
- Bug Repellent
- Anti-dizziness medication
- If you plan on taking your camera- Keep in mind that the trip is in fishing grounds so you might experience rough movements and wave breezes. Make sure that your gear is protected. Pelagic Life will not respond to any damages.

REQUIREMENTS

- Basic snorkeling knowledge
- Responsibility waiver signed before the expedition
- Good physical condition
- Swimming skills

- Tolerance to remain at open sea for a prolonged amount of time (waves, winds, tides)

DAILY RUNDOWN

- Leave by 8:45 am (approx.)
- Start chumming and luring the sharks. The process can take some time ranging from 30 min to 4 hours or more
- Break (lunch)
- Search for more pelagic life
- Return by approx. 18:00

DISCLAIMER

This is a pilot operation. We cannot assure a pelagic encounter of any kind. We will do our best to attract sharks and see other marine animals, considering that there is a possibility of not having an encounter, we are talking about the ocean after all.

We reserve the right to cancel if:

- We do not meet the minimum occupancy of 6 people, we will update you constantly.
- Our deadline is one week before the expedition. If we need to cancel the trip your deposit is 100% refundable or you can change your booking for a later date.
- Return before estimated time: The open ocean is unpredictable and conditions can change dramatically whilst at sea. If conditions worsen, we will have to come back to port. In the unlikely event that this happens we have planned on- shore activities.
- If you decide to cancel the trip, we won't be able to refund your deposit. (See Terms & Conditions)

We will do our very best to have a positive outcome during our outings. However there is always a possibility that the Pelagic Safari is canceled. For more details about cancellations please visit our "terms and conditions"

EVENTUALITY ACCORDING TO METEOROLOGICAL CONDITIONS

If predictions of meteorological conditions will not allow a safe expedition (winds of 20-30 knots with waves of 2-3 meters) we will find ourselves in the need to CANCEL the expedition. This decision will be taken 1 week prior to the trip. In case the trip is canceled we will reschedule the date or make total REFUND of your deposit.

HOW DO I GET THERE?

Puerto San Carlos is a little fishing town on the west coast of the Baja California Sur peninsula. The nearest airport is La Paz International Airport, which takes 3:30 hrs (transportation included from this point). If you plan to arrive in Los Cabos please consider that it takes an additional two to three hours more, therefore you would have to pay an extra cost.

SECURITY

The team will be providing an information session the day of arrival to San Carlos (Thursday evening before dinner). Swimming with pelagic life (sharks in particular) is a safe activity as long as the established indications and safety rules are followed. A professional guide will accompany the group on all outings and give an informative session in order to ensure the safety of all and achieve an unforgettable experience.
